**** Plus 1 elective of 3 credits**

1. Upon declaration of the minor, a student will be assigned a faculty advisor.
2. ** In addition to the courses listed above, the student must take an approved elective such as Economics 100, 101, 102 or any other elective approved by the Department of Accounting and Information Systems. See your faculty advisor.
3. C- is the minimum grade in all Accounting & Information Systems courses.
4. Students are not permitted to take courses before the required semester, nor are they permitted to register for any Accounting & Information Systems course where they have earned a grade less than C-, INC., etc. in the pre-requisite.
5. Minors in Accounting & Information Systems must complete a Concentration Form no later than their Junior Year and submit said form to their advisor for approval. (Forms are available in the Department.)
6. The C- requirement does **NOT** apply to the other approved elective if it is taken outside those courses given by the Department of Accounting & Information Systems. You may **NOT P/NC** any course that is being used to satisfy your minor requirements (including the elective). An overall C grade point average is needed in all required courses to be eligible for the minor.
7. **A MINIMUM OF 12 CREDITS MUST BE TAKEN AT QUEENS COLLEGE.**
